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APPLY TO THE PROGRAM

Students with bachelor's degrees in psychology, education, or any other related field will be considered. Master's-level applicants who majored in areas related to psychology or education will also be considered. GRE scores within the last five years are required for all applicants.

The deadline for applications is February 15 of each year.

You should submit your application materials before February 1 to allow time for processing in the department and Graduate School.
