**Solution:** I enjoy going to the movies, but first I have to finish my homework.

#### PROBLEM: LACK OF SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT

**Example:** She drive every day.

**Solution:** She drives every day.

# PROBLEM: INCORRECT NOUN PLURALS

Example: The berrys are ripe.

**Solution:** The berries are ripe.

### PROBLEM: INCORRECT PLURAL AND POSSESSIVE NOUNS

Example: The childrens' toys were donated to a charity group.

**Solution:** The children's toys were donated to a charity group.



**Example:** Where are you.

**Solution:** Where are you?

### PROBLEM: NOT FORMING COMPOUND SENTENCES

Example: It rained today. The weather report called for blue skies.

Solution: It rained today, yet the weather report called for blue skies.

#### PROBLEM: SENTENCE VARIETY

Example: Susan runs to school every morning. Susan talks to her friends before class. They don't get to class on time. Their teacher gets angry.

Solution: Susan runs to school every morning so she can talk to her friends before class begins. However, when they don't get to class on time, their teacher gets angry.

#### PROBLEM: PARAGRAPH FOCUS

**Example:** I love computer games, model cars, and comic books. All are fun! **Solution:** I enjoy many different types of leisure activities. My friends and I have a great time playing the latest computer games with the most excitement and challenge. When I want to create something on my own, I build model cars and take pride in getting every detail just right. Yet nothing beats my comic book collection if I want to kick back and relax! With all of these things to do, I'm never bored
