Autism spectrum disorder, or ASD, is a series of neurodevelopmental disorders that impair a child's ability to communicate and interact with others.





Activities and Ideas for Children with ASD

- ASD is more common than childhood cancer, diabetes, and AIDS combined.
- **2.** Boys are diagnosed with ASD four times more often than girls.
- 3. Autism affects 1 in every 50 schoolchildren in the United States.
- Researchers recommend testing children for autism if they lose previously acquired language or social skills at any age.
- 5. Approximately 5% of children with autistic siblings develop autistic disorders themselves.
