# **Environmental Issues – What's the solution?**

## Let's make a change!

#### Overview

For this lesson, students will research and become aware of an environmental of their choice. Each individual student will create a petition for change for his or her environmental issue. Each group of similar topics will create a Public Service Announcement (PSA) to encourage a change in the public view of the environmental issues they have researched.

### **Objectives**

Students will be able to...

- Describe and analysis the importance of environmental issues.
- Make a persuasive claim based on support and evidence.

#### **Co-Teaching Strategy**

One teach, one assist

#### **Procedures**

- 1. Introduce the list of potential environmental issues (15 minutes).
- 2. Instruct students in the requirements of the project and expectations (10 minutes).
- 3. Have students select topics (5 minutes).
- 4. Group students according to topic similarity (5 minutes).
- 5. Allow work time for research and PSA recording (120 minutes).
- 6. Presentation for the completed PSAs (60 minutes).
