Learning Objectives Assignment

Grade: Kindergarten **Unit/Topic**: Economics

Lesson:

This lesson will be based on helping students make smart career choices. With information provided by the teacher and special guests, students will learn about different jobs available within their communities, the important tasks these jobs accomplish on a daily basis, the skills needed to work the jobs, and the importance of earning money. This lesson will be provided during the school's career week to tie into the theme of making smart educational choices for future career goals.

- 1. Students will draw a picture of themselves in an outfit representing any career choice, along with one tool representing a responsibility.
