Grade Level:

Kindergarten

Topic:

Social Studies- Civics and Government

Description of Lesson:

This lesson will focus on the importance of being a responsible family member and member of a group. I will give the students the opportunity to act out various situations in which a person needs to critically think about when wanting to be a responsible. Groups of two to three students will act out a scene, and the rest of the class will discuss what happened. Then the students get a chance to draw their ideas of them being responsible. Finally, they will be able to present their final thoughts on what it takes to show responsibility in relation to the classroom and their school.

Objectives:

- Students will analyze a few situations and decide if the outcome represented the trait of responsibility either well or badly. (K.2.3, K.2.4)
- Students will draw a picture of themselves displaying responsibility for their family or at school. A few examples for how this can be done are by them throwing trash away, making their bed, washing dishes, or feeding the dog. (K.2.4)
- Students will present their ideas to the class of what they think a person needs to be, do, or say in order to show responsibility when at school or in the classroom. (K.2.3)
