
Qualtrics Survey Report



Within the survey are a multitude of questions types such as a multiple choice, Likert scale, short answer, and sliders. In order to distribute the survey, I posted it online to Facebook using the URL link given by Qualtrics. As a precaution, I made it know to the to whomever participated that all information given would be anonymous. Of the 57 people who took the survey, 55 responded saying they understood this. The two people who did not were automatically sent to the end of the survey and not allowed to participate any further.

From the collected data, I learned a lot about my school in terms of the families that make up the population. For example, 89% speak English and the rest speak something else. This lets me know that an education for foreign languages is needed in order to develop a worldly culture for my students. This also lets me know that I may need to hire someone who specializes in a foreign language to help those few students who need more direct attention they may not get in the general education classroom. Another example is that 15.22% of the family households make less than \$10,000 a year.
