First Grade Mathematics

These lessons will be conducted over the first 9 weeks of school. Each lesson is just one lesson with in the math unit. The students will be learning to count money, tell time and connect ordinal numbers to a set of items.

Objective: Students will identify the values of 3 sets of various coins given by their teacher.

Standard: 1.M.3: Find the value of a collection of pennies, nickels, and dimes

Objective: Students will demonstrate telling time on an analog clock to the nearest half-hour on two different occasions using the classroom clock throughout the day.

Standard: 1.M.2: Tell and write time to the nearest half-hour and relate time to events (before/after, shorter/longer) using analog clocks. Understand how to read hours and minutes using digital clocks.
